# ALBERTA MILK SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Alberta Milk Scholarship was created to help sustain the dairy industry by encouraging students to study dairy or a related agriculture discipline that furthers the dairy industry.

## NUMBER AND VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Two scholarships of \$2,500 each to be awarded in the Fall.

## QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

1. Applicants' must be from the immediate family of an Alberta Milk member in good standing or be sponsored by an Alberta Milk member in good standing.
2. Applicants' field of study will be given primary consideration. Dairy education will be given the highest preference, followed by agriculture, and other occupations that further the dairy industry.
3. Applicants must submit an application form with the requested supporting documentation. An essay, scholastic achievement, leadership skills, community involvement, and work experience will be part of the evaluation.

## ACADEMIC INSTITUTION

Any officially recognized post-secondary institution.

## YEAR OF STUDY

Any year in a diploma or bachelor's degree program or graduate studies.

## PROGRAM OF STUDY

Any post-secondary program, although preference will be given to studies in dairy, agriculture, or a related field.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

Each applicant must submit:

1. The following Application Form;
2. An essay, no longer than 500 words and address the following topic:

*How do you intend to use your education to benefit the future of Alberta's dairy industry? In addition to your education, highlight how your volunteer and leadership experiences will assist you in contributing to a vibrant dairy industry.*

3. A resume, no longer than two pages. It should outline any employment or volunteer experience, as well as personal achievements.
4. An original copy of the applicants' most recent post-secondary academic transcripts. Arrangements should be made for applicants' college or university to send an original copy of their transcript bearing the institution's official seal, to Alberta Milk. Transcripts must be received by Alberta Milk no later than July 15, 2026. Transcripts that are photocopied or faxed will not be accepted.
5. If the applicant is being sponsored by an Alberta Milk member, a letter of recommendation from the sponsor is to be included.

Essays will be evaluated for content, quality of thought and must not exceed 500 words.

Transcripts must be received by Alberta Milk no later than July 15, 2026. **Transcripts that are photocopied or faxed will not be accepted.**
- If you are being sponsored by a dairy producer, include a letter from your sponsor indicating why you should be considered for the Alberta Milk Scholarship.
